LAND BILL: MARGINAL STRIPS ON FASTORAL LEASEHOLD LAND

SAS (88) 24

The Committee:

- agreed that new marginal strips legislation now in preparation will apply to all 2 future dispositions of Crown land, including new leases and licences, under the new Land Act:
- b agreed that new marginal strips legislation will continue provisions similar to those in section 58(3) of the Land Act 1948 allowing the Crown to apply the new marginal strips policy to unsurveyed pastoral land;
- agreed that section 58 of the Land Act 1948 will be consequently repealed and C replaced by reference to the proposed marginal strips provisions in the Conservation Act 1987:
- đ noted that under the new marginal strips legislation all section 58 strips where they currently exist will be declared to be held for conservation purposes under section 7 of the Conservation Act 1987.
